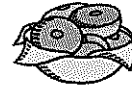

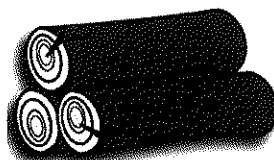

Real Estate Taxes may be paid in two installments, with the first installment due to the Town Treasurer on or before January 31, 2015. The second half must be paid to the County Treasurer on or before July 31, 2015. As a reminder the Walworth County Treasurer's office **DOES NOT** send out reminders for your second half payment. If you pay your taxes in full, the due date for payment is January 31, 2015. All Personal Property Taxes, Special Assessments, Special Charges, and Special Taxes of \$99.99 or less per parcel must be paid in full.

1st Installment Due January 31st
BY MAIL * IN PERSON*ON LINE*NIGHT DEPOSIT

Don't forget the first installment amount on your tax bill is due by January 31st. If you mail your payment and need a receipt, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope. We do not give on the spot refunds for mortgage checks, so plan ahead.

Remember Walworth County no longer sends out a reminder for second installments. You will have to pay the second installment to the Walworth County Treasurer by July 31, 2015.

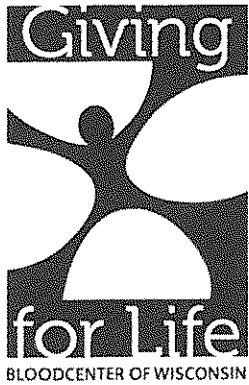
FAZOLI RESTAURANT'S "FRIENDLY READER PROGRAM"
