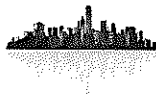

1. To adopt the 2015 town tax levy to be collected in 2016 pursuant to Section 60.10(1)(a) of Wisconsin Statutes.
2. To approve total highway expenditures for 2016 pursuant to Section 82.03 of Wisconsin Statutes.
3. Approve to raise the salaries of Chairperson and Town Supervisors effective with the terms beginning April 2016 and April 2017

Walworth County Sheriff's Department

In the month of September, the Walworth County Sheriff's Department responded to 226 calls in the Town of Darien. This would break down to 7.2 calls a day. Some of the calls include: and EMS & fire calls, OVWI, misdial 911, traffic stop, assist motorist, civil process, CMV inspection, business check, reckless driver, electronic monitoring check, MVA-injury, disorderly conduct person, 911 hang-up, damage to property, controlled burn, drunkenness, obstructing officer, suspicious, arrest person, attempt to locate, welfare check, debris in roadway, dog at large, drugs, livestock loose, child abuse-neglect, family offense, liquor, neighbor trouble, MVA-hit & run, threats, abandoned vehicle, assist other departments, bail-jumping-misc., death-investigation, and lock-out.

OCTOBER TOWN BOARD MEETING

During the October Town Board Meeting the Town Board Supervisors approved two intergovernmental agreements with the Village of Darien, WW Trucking (Hilltop Securities LLC) rezone from A-4 to M2 and one operator's license for Show Palace. There were discussions regarding the Creek Road Project, Foundry Road, and the Darien Town Hall. 2016 Budget Public Hearing

The public is invited and encouraged to attend the public hearing regarding the 2016 Village of Darien Budget on Monday, November 9, 2015, at 7:00 pm in the Board Room at Darien Village Hall, 24 N. Wisconsin Street, Darien.



The Village Board will take public comment on the budget and may potentially approve the budget at this meeting. You may review a copy of the proposed budget at Village Hall during regular office hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm) or on the Village's website: www.darienwi.com.

Are you interested in running for the Darien Village Board of Trustees?

Nomination packets and paperwork will be available for Village residents seeking a seat on the Village Board of Trustees starting on Monday, November 9, 2015, at Village Hall. Potential candidates for the three seats on the April ballot may begin circulating nomination papers and collecting signatures on Tuesday, December 1, 2015. All completed forms and nomination papers are due to the Village Administrator/Clerk-Treasurer by Tuesday, January 5, 2016, at 5:00 pm. The spring election will take place on Tuesday, April 5, 2016, and newly-elected Trustees will take office on Monday, April 18, 2016. Please contact Village Hall for more information.

ELECTION 2016 Be Prepared to Vote in 2016!

In 2016, every voter must provide photo identification when voting by absentee ballot or at the polls. There is not a separate "Voter ID" card required. However, there are many forms of acceptable photo ID which you likely already have that can be used for voting purposes.

The following photo IDs are acceptable and can be unexpired or expired after the date of the most recent general election (November 4, 2014 election):

- A Wisconsin DOT-issued driver license, even if driving privileges are revoked or suspended
- A Wisconsin DOT-issued identification card
- Military ID card issued by the U.S. Uniformed Services
- A U.S. Passport book or card.

The following photo IDs are also acceptable for voting purposes:

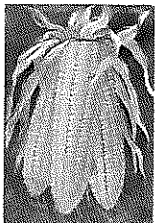
- A certificate of naturalization (that was issued not earlier than two years before the date of the election)
- An identification card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe in Wisconsin
- A driver license receipt issued by the Wisconsin DOT (valid for 45 days from the date issued)
- An identification card receipt issued by the Wisconsin DOT (valid 45 days from the date issued)
- A photo identification card issued by a Wisconsin accredited university or college, or technical college that contains the following:
 - Date the card was issued
 - Signature of student
 - Expiration date no later than two years after the date of issuance
 - The university or college ID must be accompanied by a separate document that proved enrollment, such as a tuition fee receipt, enrollment verification letter, or class schedule.

There are not any additional elections in 2015; however, save the dates for the 2016 Elections:

- February 16, 2016 – Spring Primary Election (if needed)
- April 5, 2016 – Spring Election and Presidential Preference Primary
- August 9, 2016 – Partisan Primary Election
- November 8, 2016 – General and Presidential Election.

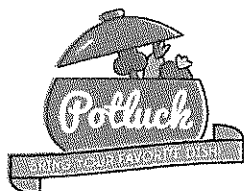

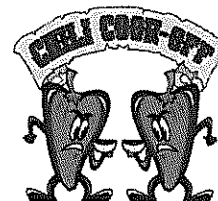
