Walworth County Sheriff's Department

In the month of February; the Walworth County Sheriff's Department responded to 287 calls in the Town of Darien. This would break down to 9.9 calls a day. Some of the calls include: EMS & fire calls, reckless driver, house checks, civil process, assist motorists, theft, weapons, emergency detention, warrant attempt, trespassing, open door/window, debris in roadway, fire-alarm, abandoned vehicles, speeding, protective custody, MVA-PD, dog at large, tree down, 911-open line, controlled burn checks, car in ditches, sign down, attempt to locate, unknown problem, disorderly conduct – person, meeting, drugs, animal miscellaneous, MVA-hit & run PD, disorderly conduct – fighting, mental, and 911 hang-up.

Creek Road Project

Lawson School Road to Old 89

On Tuesday, March 1st, the Town Board of Supervisors voted on the contract bid for the Creek Road Project and awarded it to Payne & Dolan for \$923,923.00. This is a TRID project (**Town Road Improvement Discretionary**) which is a component of the Local Roads Improvement Program. This program assists local units of government in improving seriously deteriorating roads under the authority of local governments.

Our particular project was one of fifty-two TRID projects selected in Wisconsin for funding. The WisDOT will reimburse the Town of Darien for Creek Road project total cost, to a limit of \$494,868.47. The Creek Road project will begin in May 2016.

Ordinance No. 2016 -1

An Ordinance Designating All-Terrain Vehicle Routes

The Town Board of the Town of Darien WI hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Wis Stat. 23.33(8)(b) the following Town roads are hereby designated as all-terrain vehicle routes for use by both all-terrain vehicles and utility terrain vehicles as provided under Wis Stat. 23.33 – All of Clinton Street, All of John Street, All of Hill Street, and North Road, between the intersections Clinton Street and Hill Street.

Spring Election & Presidential Preference Primary

To be held on April 5, 2016

The Spring Election and Presidential Preference Primary will be held on April 5, 2016 in the Village of Darien. In addition to the local contests on the ballot: Village Board, School Board, County Board, and Walworth County Circuit Court Judge; and the Wisconsin Supreme Court Judge; electors may also vote in the state-wide primary for the Presidential election that will take place this fall.

Village residents will vote at Village Hall in the Board Room. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Remember to bring your photo identification card to vote! New Village residents or those who have changed their name or moved since the last election may register to vote on Election Day and will need to bring a valid form of proof of residence to do so. Wisconsin's Tornado & Severe Weather Awareness Week

Governor Walker has declared April 11-15, 2016 as Wisconsin's Tornado & Severe Weather Awareness Week. Wisconsin Emergency

Management, the National Weather Service (NWS), and the Wisconsin Broadcasters Association (WBA) have once again teamed up to sponsor the statewide tornado drill scheduled for Thursday, April 14th. For the first time, a mock tornado warning will be issued at 6:55 p.m. on Thursday, April 14th to give families and businesses a chance to test their emergency severe weather plans. Earlier in the day, a mock tornado watch will be issued at 1:00 p.m. and a mock tornado warning will be issued at 1:45 p.m. Many radio and TV stations across the state will issue the test tornado warnings. In addition, mock alerts will be issued on NOAA Weather Radios and many communities will test their tornado sirens.
