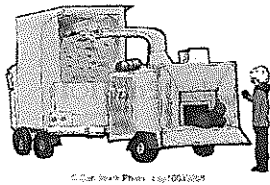

Passing Farm Equipment

As of January 15, 2015, Wisconsin Act 377 does not allow motorist to pass farm equipment or any other vehicles in a no passing zone designated by signs or a solid yellow line on the pavement on your side of the center line.

When you pass on a two lane road, you must leave the right lane early enough and remain in the left lane long enough to pass without interfering with the other vehicle. It's your responsibility when passing to make sure it's safe. It is the other driver's responsibility to give way and let you pass without speeding up.

Take extra care when passing bicycles. They must be given at least three feet of clearance.

Walworth County Sheriff Department

In the month of March; the Walworth County Sheriff Dept. responded to 279 calls in the Town of Darien. This would break down to 9.0 calls a day. Some of the calls include: traffic stops of overweight vehicles on Class B roads, misc. traffic stops, prisoner transport, car in ditch, trespassing, welfare checks, electronic monitoring check, business checks, house checks, 911 hang ups, 911 open lines, animal neglect, extra patrol on some town roads, controlled burn checks, owvi (operating a vehicle while under the influence) traffic stop, and responses to fire and EMS calls.

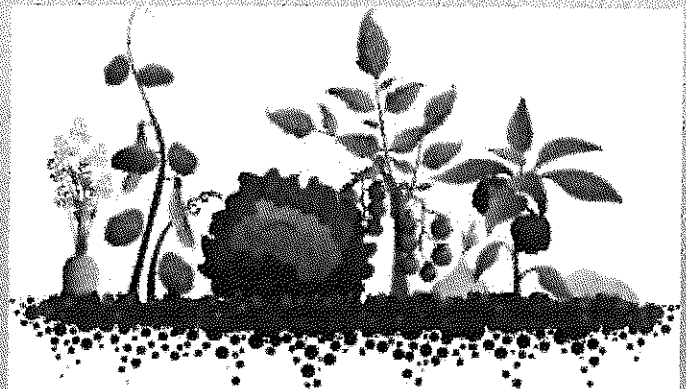
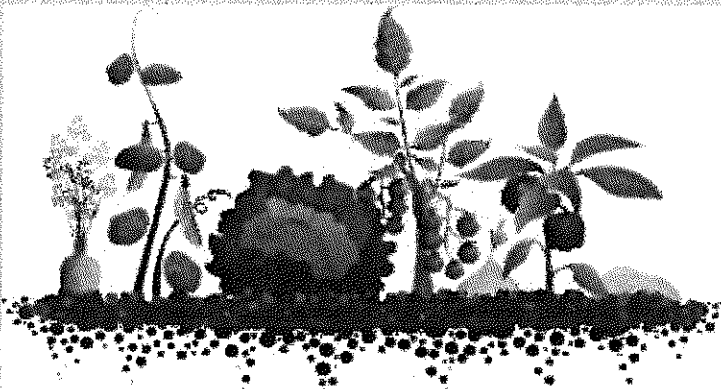

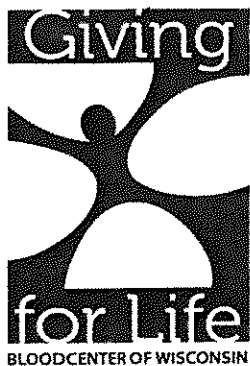
