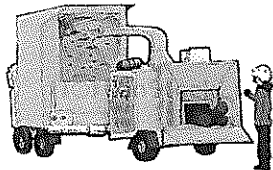

Public Works – Brush Collection

There will be a brush collection the **week of June 1st**, weather permitting. If you are planning to have brush at the end of your driveway and have questions regarding the amount of brush and size of the limbs, please call the Public Works Superintendent Bob Williams at 882-3658.



Purchased a New Tractor for Public Works Department

On May 6th the Town accepted delivery of a 2014 Case Maxxum 125 tractor. By trading the New Holland tractor and with government discounts, the Town purchased the tractor for less than what the town budgeted. The tractor's extras include a loader, forks, broom, and a bucket.

The tractor will be used for mowing and grading roadsides, loading salt and sand in the winter, moving trees off the roads after severe storms, and any other use that may arise.

Joint Agreement with the Town & Village of Darien Upgrading West Park

The Town and Village have entered into an agreement to replace the playground equipment and construct a walking path on the perimeter of West Park. The Town will contribute 50% of the cost up to \$42,500. Town residents will be able to use West Park at the same cost (if any) as Village residents.

2015 Road Work

Crack Filling Services has been awarded work on Pleasant Street, Springwood Lane, Sunshine Lane, Kenny Lane, and Lawson School Road. Work will be completed in early June.

Scott Construction has been awarded the Seal Coating bid on Kenny Lane, Pleasant Street, Springwood Lane and Sunshine Lane. Work will start in mid-June. Sweeping up the excess material slag seal coating will be done about two weeks after the work has been completed.

Payne & Dolan has been awarded the paving bid on Ridge Prairie School Road and also half of a mile on the east end of R & D Townline Road. This is scheduled to start at the end of June or beginning of July.

All dates are subject to change due to weather. When traveling on these roads while work is being done, please drive with caution.

Walworth County Sheriff's Department

In the month of April, the Walworth County Sheriff's Department responded to 211 calls in the Town of Darien. This would break down to 7.0 calls a day. Some of the calls include: found property, business checks, 911 hang-ups, 911 open lines, warrant attempt, reckless driver, barking dogs, OVWI (Operating a vehicle while under the influence), prostitution, animal miscellaneous, damage to property, traffic stops, fire alarm – businesses, speeding, signs down, suspicious, family offense, disorderly conduct – group, weather alert, road hazard, electronic monitoring checks, and EMS and fire calls.

Noxious Weeds

NOTICE IS HEREBY given to each person who owns, occupies, or controls land in the Town of Darien, Walworth County, Wisconsin, to destroy all noxious weeds on such property before the plants bloom.

Failure to destroy these weeds will result in the Weed Commissioner causing such weeds to be destroyed and the cost thereof levied as a special tax against the property pursuant Wisconsin Statutes Section 66.0407.

Wisconsin Street Reconstruction Project

Reconstruction of Wisconsin Street, from Beloit Street just past Fremont Street, is expected to begin on **July 7, 2015**, with an expected completion date of **September 1, 2015**. The street will be open to local traffic throughout construction. However, those visiting Village Hall and other businesses and residences on Wisconsin Street will need to find alternate parking during construction. When complete, the block of Wisconsin Street between Beloit Street and Fremont Street will have a new asphalt street surface, concrete curb and gutter, and epoxy lane and parking space markings. Further, the two steps on the east side of the street will be leveled to allow at-grade access from the street to the sidewalk and buildings. The street will also feature solid, double yellow center lines, which prohibits U-turns at any time. Signs prohibiting U-turns will also be posted at each end and along this block of Wisconsin Street. The Village has requested additional enforcement of the law prohibiting U-turns upon completion of the project.

A cooperative agreement between the Village and the Town will bring both new ADA-accessible playground equipment and a new ¾-mile limestone walking trail to West Park this year. Village Changes Swimming Pool Ordinance

On May 18th, the Village Board voted to amend the existing ordinance regulating swimming pools and fencing requirements. The amended ordinance provides definitions of several different types of swimming pools, including inflatable pools, frame or hard-sided pools, permanent above-ground pools, and in-ground pools. The amended ordinance requires a fence for inflatable pools, frame or hard-sided pools less than four feet in height, and in-ground pools. In order to secure frame or hard-sided pools that are four feet or greater in height and permanent above-ground pools, the amended ordinance requires one of the following: fencing; built-in fencing with a self-closing, lockable gate; or a removable and/or lockable ladder. Weeds and Grasses

The Village Hall receives many calls this time of year concerning the height of weeds and grass. Weeds and grass should not exceed a height of one foot. The Village often has no choice but to order the destruction of such weeds and the cutting of the grass. The cost of this action is then billed to the property owner.

Compost Site

The Village Recycling / Compost Site is located at 339 Oak Street (Water Tower #1). The mulch at this site is for use by Village residents only. Other materials such as gravel are for the use of the Department of Public Works. Site is open: Weekdays 7:00 am – 3:30 pm / Saturday 7:00 am – Noon.

Bicycles are Not Allowed on Downtown Sidewalks

Bicycles and other wheeled devices are not allowed on the sidewalks on Wisconsin Street from Beloit Street to Fremont Street and Beloit Street from Wisconsin Street to Market Street.

NEW CHRISTIAN "CLEAN READ" GUIDEPOSTS FICTION SERIES

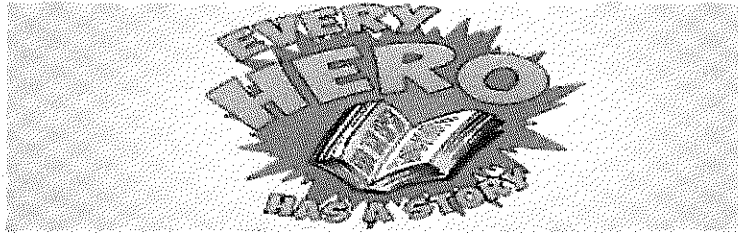

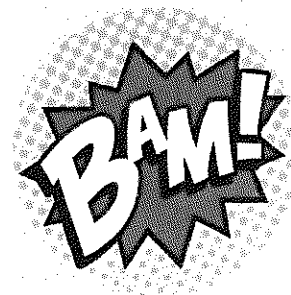

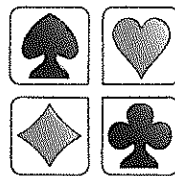
